

# DO YOUR PART. SHOW US THE MARKS.

White Line your way to a safe dig! It's a key step in the 811 process. It allows the locate technician to focus ONLY on the area where you intend to dig, which eliminates excess utility marker flags and creates greater efficiencies for the 811 system.

1. Mark the area you intend to dig by using white paint and/or flags to visually convey to utility locators where the work is taking place.
2. Contact Indiana 811 at least two full working days before you dig by going to [www.Indiana811.org](http://www.Indiana811.org) or by calling 811.
3. The utility locate technician will arrive and know precisely where the digging is taking place.
